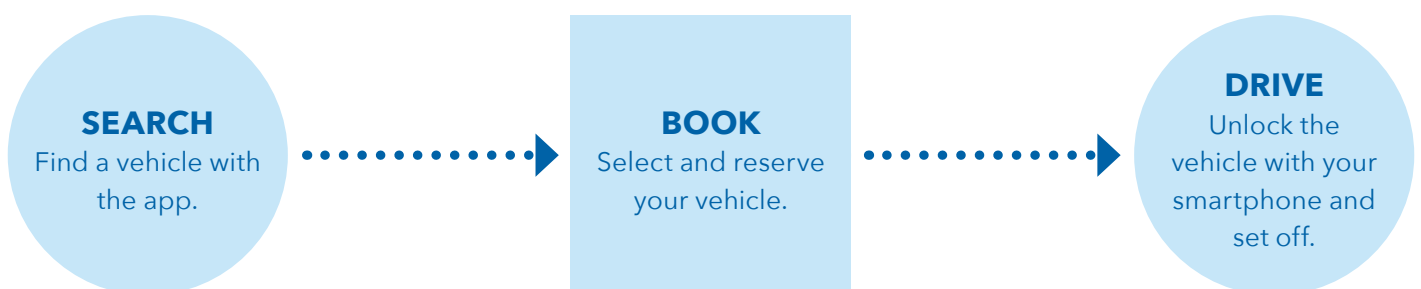


GUIDE TO USING SWISS E-CAR VEHICLES



E-carsharing in your region: download the app and get going



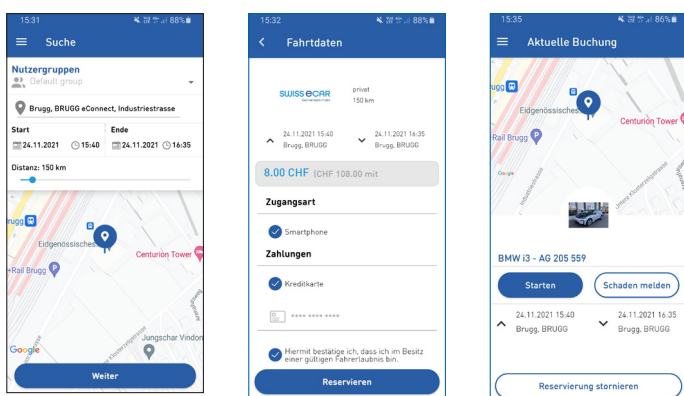
REGISTRATION AND BOOKING

1. Register

Find all the information you need at www.swisse-car.ch and download the «Swiss E-Car» App from the app store. After registering, submit a photo of your driver's license and your ID. You will receive confirmation (within 24 hours) once your documents have been checked. That's all you need to start using «Swiss E-Car».

2. Book and drive

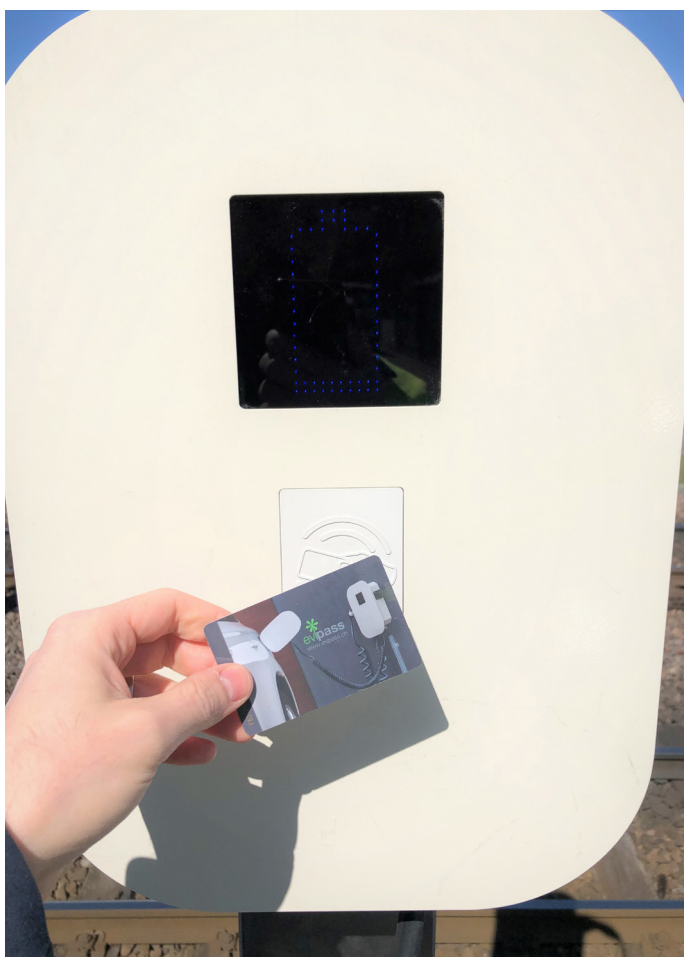
Select and book your chosen vehicle with your smartphone. Unlock the car by smartphone, and you're ready to go.



Reserve a car

- 1 Open the app.
- 2 Select a vehicle.
- 3 Book Swiss E-Car for the required period.
- 4 Your reservation will appear in the booking calendar. You can select the reservation to edit or delete it.

HIT THE ROAD



Vehicle immobiliser

An automatic immobiliser system will be activated if you do not start up the vehicle within 5 minutes of opening it. If this happens, select the green «Open» button in the app and then start the car.

Open the vehicle and disconnect the cable

- 1 Open the vehicle with the app (go to «Booking» ► Select booking ► start current booking ► Open with the green key).
- 2 Answer the questions in the app about the vehicle's condition.
- 3 Unlock the charging point with the card in the vehicle glove compartment.
- 4 Detach the charging cable from the vehicle and hook it up in the charging point.

IMPORTANT

Please always put the charging cable for the «home» charging point in the slot at the charging point before you drive away. Always check before setting off that there is a charging cable under the bonnet.



Start your journey

You do not need a key to start the car.

- 1 Press the start/stop button (on the right of the steering wheel)
- 2 Release the brake and press the start/stop button (on the right of the steering wheel)
- 3 Set the gear lever (on the right of the steering wheel) to auf «D» (drive) or «R» (reverse)



During your journey

Optimise vehicle range.

Enable Eco Pro mode/Eco Pro+ mode (the switch is on the centre console) to optimise vehicle range. Speed is limited to 130/90 km/h..

The battery is charged with recovered kinetic energy as soon as you operate the brake or release the accelerator.

This regenerative braking process means that the vehicle brakes very rapidly compared to a diesel/petrol engine - be prepared for this the first time you slow down.





Ending your journey

Please always park Swiss E-Car vehicles in the marked parking space. Connect the car to the charging point so that the battery is fully charged for the next user.

- 1 Brake
- 2 Press «P» (park)
- 3 Press the start/stopp button (on the right of the steering wheel) ► The motor will stop
- 4 Engage the handbrake (centre console)
- 5 Open the port cap
- 6 To extract the charging cable from the charging point: press the small button on the charging point
- 7 Insert the charging cable all the way
- 8 Activate the charging point with the card (in the gloce compartment)
- 9 Check car is charging ► Blue light on the charging point
- 10 Put card back in glove compartment
- 11 Open the app and end the reservation («End rental» key ► Answer questions on vehicle condition ► Vehicle locks automatically when reservation is ended)

IMPORTANT

Please always check that the charging cable is correctly connected to the vehicle and the vehicle is charging (battery symbol should be blue). Follow the instructions on the vehicle display.

Important charging information

Please check for charging points on your route before starting long journeys.
